Constance "Connie" Murphy Hatfield, 84, a long-time resident of LaPlace and Norco, LA, passed away Saturday, March 16, 2019.

Constance Janet Joiner was born July 30, 1934 in Cotton, GA, the daughter of Hershel and Eloise Joiner. She was a graduate of Andrew College in Cuthbert, GA, class of 1953 and Southeastern Louisiana University in Hammond, LA, class of 1973 & 1974 where she earned both her Bachelor of Arts and Master's degrees in Early Childhood Education. She married Norton Hendry Murphy in 1953 and they made their home in many places starting in Mount Pleasant, GA, Murfreesboro, TN, Atlanta, GA, Panama City, FL, and then settled in LaPlace, LA in 1969. After Norton passed in 1989, Connie married Thomas "Tommy" B. Hatfield of Norco, LA, in 1993. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in LaPlace.

Connie taught Kindergarten at LaPlace Elementary for 20 years from 1975 until her retirement in 1995 where she was beloved by both parents and students alike. Connie was grounded in her faith and devotion in the United Methodist Church, which carried her through many rough and difficult times.
