Adam (Pete) Willie Pitre of LaPlace passed away Friday, June 21, 2024, at the age of 91.

Pete was married for 62 years to the love of his life, the late Theresa Rodi Pitre. They shared two children, Curt (Denise) and the late Michael.

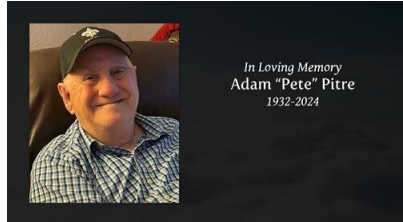
