It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Belinda Marie Brignac Moore, who departed this life on Wednesday, November 20, 2024, at the age of 75. Born in Reserve, Louisiana, Belinda was a long-time resident of Garyville, Louisiana, where she spent her life surrounded by family and the community she called home.

She was also a passionate fan of Elvis Presley and cherished a memorable vacation to Graceland with her sons, where she was thrilled to drive her car onto the property.
