Brenda Ann St. Germain Mauldin was born in Reserve, Louisiana, on Monday, 9 July, 1956, and passed on the next world on Wednesday, 16 June 2021, at the age of 64 years, 11 months, and 7 days. She was the daughter of Ridley Joseph St. Germain and Inez Mae Berthelot St. Germain, the third of five children. She is survived by her daughter, Miranda Lynn Mauldin Ford; her son-in-law JustinDavid Ford; her grandchildren Noah, Scarlett, and Zachary Ford; and her siblings, Robert (Bob) P. St. Germain, Marjorie (Marge) S. Roussell, William (Bill) J. St. Germain, and Susan S. Derenbecker, and numerous nephews, nieces, and cousins.
