Camilla Vutera Milioto, passed away January 28, 2017. Born on February 3, 1921, in Independence, Louisiana, Camilla grew up in the strawberry farming community of Hammond, and became a resident of Laplace as a young woman in December 1940, when she married Dominick J. Milioto, to whom she was married for 59 years until Dominick's death in 1999.
