'stop bringing food over, just come to visit, you don't need to bring food'!! Finally, she 'rather' complied, but would still bring something...smaller, but never was she completely empty handed.

We are so glad, this precious kind soul, walked back into our lives and to the door after Dad died. But...unfortunately, now, when the doorbell unexpectedly rings, it gives pause...as it slowly sinks in, that it's not going to be our dear friend...It's not Diane, not now.

But thankfully, Jesus promised a resurrection. And at that time, in the not-so-distant future, the knock on the door, may well be our precious friend...once again.

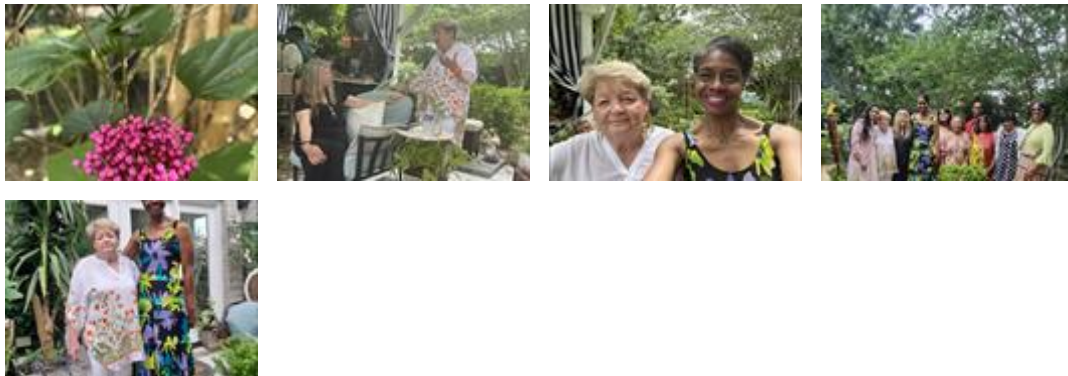
