Donald Paul Seiser, a veteran of the United States Army and a master of many trades, passed away on February 27, 2026, at the age of 81. Born on March 10, 1944, in White Plains, New York, Donald was the son of the late Mary Young Seiser and Joseph Paul Seiser, Jr.

A proud patriot, Donald served his country with honor in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War.
