He never judged anyone, but was happy to advise those that asked for his advice. He always answered his phone and talked to his clients. The Gospel according to Fred: "Life's not fair", "Being right means nothing", "I can't answer all of your questions" and "I can't do something for you yesterday". He was a person that once you met him, you never could forget him.

For the last seven years, Fred bravely battled Parkinson's Disease, and now, Elvis (Fred) has left the building.

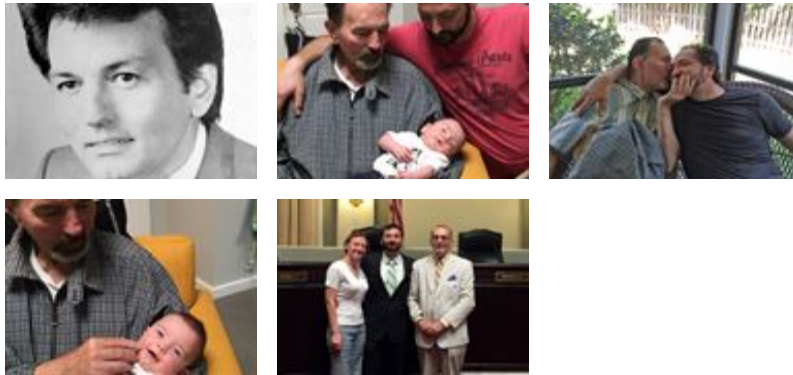

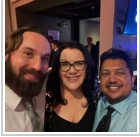
