



Jackie "Jack" Stillwell

February 18, 1953 - August 3, 2025

Jackie "Jack" Stillwell, 72, of LaPlace, Louisiana, passed away peacefully on August 3, 2025, after a courageous battle with cancer.

Born on February 18, 1953, Jack lived a life marked by extraordinary accomplishments and an even greater devotion to those he loved. He is survived by his devoted wife of 49 years, Thea; daughters Jamie and Savannah; beloved granddaughters Jaci and Sara; and siblings Jimmy, JoAnn, Terry, and Karen. He was preceded in death by his parents James and Nora Stillwell, and siblings Sharon, Allen, Norma, and Mary Jane. He also leaves behind a host of nieces, nephews, and countless friends whose lives were touched by his kindness.

Jack's name is etched into the history of boxing. Growing up in the Harahan Boxing Club, he became a world-class competitor with a remarkable career record of 194–16. He won multiple Golden Gloves titles, AAU Championships, and was selected for the U.S. Olympic Team. His legacy in the sport is so profound that a street in Westwego bears his name in recognition of his contributions to boxing.

Yet, for all his athletic triumphs, Jack's greatest legacy was his unwavering love for his family and friends. Known for his calm demeanor, steadfast compassion in times of adversity, and an infectious laugh that could fill a

room, Jack was a man who loved deeply and lived generously. His presence brought comfort, his words carried wisdom, and his heart never failed to make space for others.

Jack's impact on those fortunate enough to know him will endure long beyond his years. His life was one of discipline, humility, loyalty, and love—a true champion both in and out of the ring.

A celebration of Jack's life will be held on August 16, 2025 at Millet-Guidry Funeral Home in LaPlace, beginning at 9:00 am with the service to follow at 11:00am.

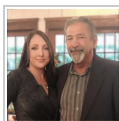

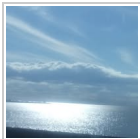
