John P. Montgomery, of LaPlace, Louisiana, passed away on April 4, 2024, at the age of 79. John leaves behind his wife, Ruth Frary Montgomery, his son, Stefan Montgomery (Charish), sister Harriet Teichert, his grandchildren, Johnathan Montgomery and Alison Montgomery, his nieces Donna Choate, Annette Teichert and nephew, Donald Teichert. John earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of West Georgia, before being drafted into the United States Army during the Vietnam war. He immediately began working to provide counseling and health care services to victims of Hurricane Katrina, through St. Anna's Episcopal Church in New Orleans. John continued to personally visit and care for some of those elderly victims until his death. John's greatest love was to serve others, and he volunteered his time as the senior warden of the vestry at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church in LaPlace, Louisiana.

When he was not helping people, John enjoyed music, photography, his cats, and most importantly spending time with his beloved wife of 37 years, Ruth.

His presence will be dearly missed by all that knew him.
