



## Joseph Damon Lozano

July 31, 1974 - November 5, 2024

Joseph Damon Lozano passed away on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at the age of 50. He was born in New Orleans, Louisiana. He spent his childhood in LaPlace, LA, graduating from Riverside Academy in Reserve, LA in 1993. Following High School he attended Loyola University in New Orleans, LA. For 10 years he worked at Riverlands Country Club in Laplace where he loved meeting and talking with guests and members of the club. Damon left an indelible mark on all who knew him. He later worked at B.A.L. and associates' drug and alcohol testing as a Forensic Collector. Damon was an avid and loyal fan of both the city of New Orleans and the New Orleans Saints, attending all home games for 20 years, and spending some time as a member of the Dome Patrol pod cast. His love of the city was never more evident than on Superbowl Sunday 2/07/2010. After much thought and deliberation he chose to stay here in New Orleans and watch the game rather than travel to Miami. His reasoning was simple, if the Saints won the game, he wanted to be here to celebrate with the city.

Damon was preceded in death by parents Joe and Eileen Lozano as well as his brother, Danny Lozano.

Damon is survived by his brother of David Lozano (Lisa). Damon always wore a smile when he was around his nieces and nephews Brandon Lozano, Mikey Lozano (Heather), Danille Lozano-Walia (Prabh), Michelle Hales (Dustin), and Angelle Anders (Garret). He is also survived by many great nieces and nephews.
