



Lloyd B. Johnson

October 22, 1929 - May 29, 2017

Lloyd B. Johnson was born on October 22, 1929 in Gatesville, Texas, and was a resident of LaPlace for 70 years, passed away at his residence surrounded with family by his side on May 29, 2017. A devoted husband, father, grandfather, he is survived by his loving wife of 66 years, Marie Ferraro Johnson, one daughter Toni Johnson Flynn (Harold) and 2 grandchildren Matthew Flynn and Ellen Flynn Benedetto (Daniel). He was preceded in death by his daughter Jill Marie, parents Leonard L. Johnson and Ruby Lee Johnson, and sister Carol J. Arcuri Alleman. Lloyd was a graduate of Leon Godchaux High School, 1948. He began his Public Service career as a St. John Parish Deputy Sheriff for 6 years and served as Sheriff for 20 ½ years. He was a member of and served as President of the Louisiana Sheriff's Association, 1991-1992, served on numerous National Law Enforcement Boards, and local civic boards including the St. John Parish Council on Aging. 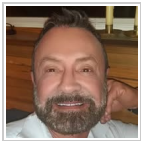

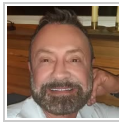
