I wired the home on Dorel Lane, I wired the first A3M shop/office, I replaced all electrical services and bad wiring in the home he had in Pass Christian after Katrina. It was an electrical job that turned out to be much more. Seemed like each time my brother Steve Gennaro showed up something else had hampered the operation. But knowing how he felt about our decisions he agreed to what needed to be done. later he and Billie both told me that they only after completion realized all we had done. It was the first home in Pass Christians , Mississippi to get electrical service back after the storm. He was so impressed when he and Billie first pulled up after Steve and I had worked for 3 straight days in a row getting it back in shape. They were greeted with a clean home and the street in front of it. They were kinda embarrassed about the other homes that had not yet started to re-build. We did not make the first curfew so we were detained by Pass Christian Police Department and Pat was notified. He later called and messed with us both. They were first to have a 4th of July celebration at there home after the storm. Later on he wanted to add an oil press at the new A3M shop and Steve and I wired it also.

Y'all I could go on forever with all that Pat and I were involved in, I can only imagine the loss Billie and all those children and grandchildren are going through.

Pat will be missed by many many people, and St. John Parish has lost a key pillar of the community.

I will say that this is a man whom I will never forget and am so proud to have known him.

Pat fly high my friend and know you will be missed by so many and we have lost a great person.
