



## Raymond "Ray" H. Robertson

Raymond "Ray" H. Robertson, a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, veteran, and faithful servant of God, passed away peacefully on November 30, 2025, at the age of 79.

Born on May 31, 1946, in New Orleans, Louisiana, Ray spent his life rooted in faith, family, and service. He and his beloved wife, Claudia Robertson, shared 59 years of marriage filled with love, laughter, and unwavering commitment. Together, they built a family that was the center of his world.
