He was a lector and active member at St. Hubert Church. Sammy was a member of the Garyville Volunteer Fire Department. He was one of the original radio announcers at WCKW in Garyville. Sammy was a member of the Rebels Band with Gary Breaux, member of the L.S.U. Band (clarinet) and member of the L.S.U. ROTC. Sammy loved Dixieland Jazz, cars, gardening and cutting grass on his riding lawnmower. He also adored his pets, Pup, Whitey, Bullet and Tippy. Sammy was the dependable patriarch of the entire Miano family whom he loved very much. His photographic memory and knowledge of many things helped his family greatly. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.
