Terry Labat passed away on Friday, June 15, 2018 at the age of 68. He was born in Baton Rouge and was a life-long resident of LaPlace. Beloved husband of Trudy Haydel Labat. Most recently he has spent the last 12 years serving as Treasurer of St. John Ministry of Care. As a 16 year old, he received the rank of Eagle Scout and during his time in the Lion's Club and the Knights of Columbus he was awarded Lion of the Year in 2002 and Knight of the Month multiple times. He also received the RSVP Award for Most Volunteer Hours in St. John Parish for seven years in a row.
