Todd Michael Hymel passed away on May 5, 2026, after a battle with lung cancer at the age of 59. He was a lifelong resident of LaPlace, Louisiana. Todd was born to Bryan F. Hymel and Marie Etta Vicknair. He was a graduate of East St. John High School in Reserve, Louisiana, and went on to graduate from Loyola University in New Orleans, Louisiana. Todd married Nancy Calcagno Hymel of Montz, Louisiana, on February 9, 1985.

Todd was a loving father to three sons, Dustin Hymel, Jeremy Hymel, and Blake Hymel. He will be deeply missed. He was cherished by his family and friends. He followed in his father's footsteps with a passion for cooking and was always there when anyone needed help. Like his father, he was a loving and giving person, always thinking of ways to make people laugh.

Todd approached everything with enthusiasm and jumped in with both feet. He enjoyed building model trains. He ran two businesses—one selling darts out of his garage and another doing flooring locally in LaPlace, Louisiana. Todd worked for the St. John Parish Sheriff's Office from 1985 to 2012. He started in the radio room and worked his way up to Detective. He later partnered with the FBI, working on an FBI Task Force from 2006-2009 after graduating from the FBI National Academy in 2002. In 2017, he began working for FEMA, where he remained until 2026, when he was diagnosed with cancer.

Todd is survived by his three sons, Dustin Hymel, Jeremy Hymel, and Blake Hymel and his wife, Lauren; his mother, Marie Etta Vicknair; his sister, Angela

Andry; his nephew, Christopher Andry and his wife, Sarah; and his niece, Nicole Andry.
